The bicycle

In 1817, German baron Karl Drais invented the «draisine»: two wooden wheels, no pedals, propelled by the feet. The ancestor of the modern bicycle!

The ballpoint pen

In 1938, Hungarian inventor László Bíró patented the ballpoint pen. Tired of ink smudges from fountain pens, he invented a rotating ball tip that revolutionized everyday writing.

The barcode

On June 26, 1974, a pack of Wrigley's chewing gum became the first product scanned at a checkout in a supermarket. An invention that today equips billions of products worldwide.

Sunscreen

In 1936, Austrian chemist Franz Greiter returned from a hike with a terrible sunburn. He then set out to develop the world's first sunscreen.

The first man in space

On April 12, 1961, Soviet cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin became the first man to leave Earth. He completed a full orbit of our planet in just 108 minutes.



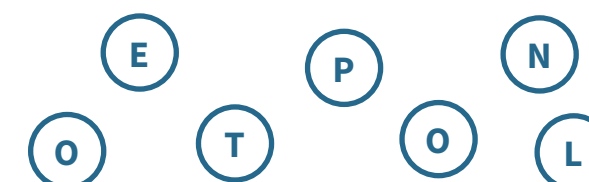
