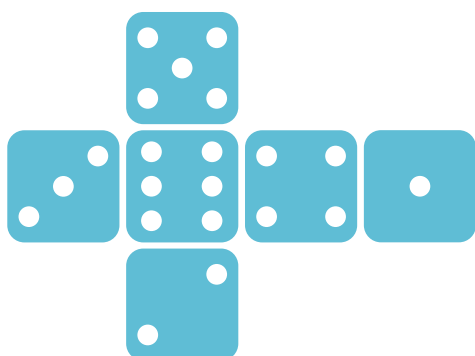
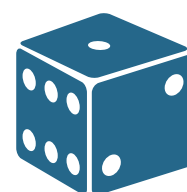
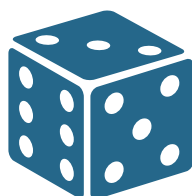
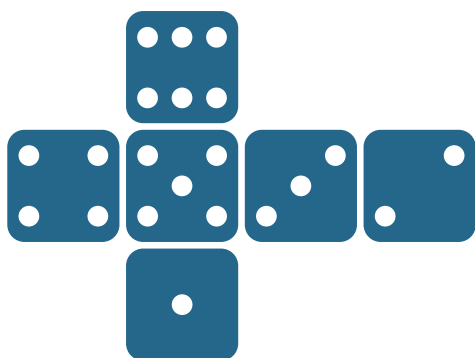


## Which die is impossible?

For each one, read the hint and try to identify the artist's name.

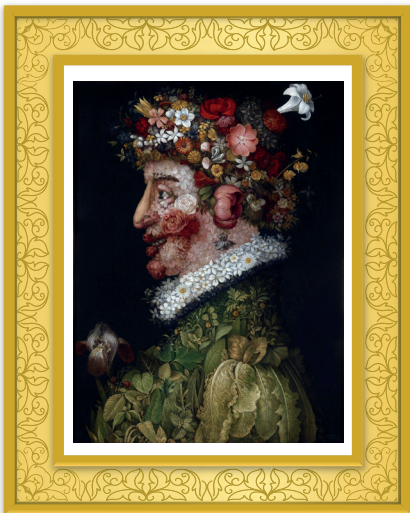

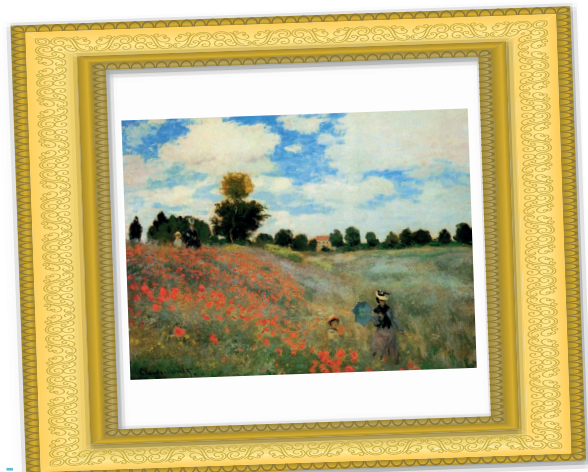
A vase filled with yellow sunflowers.

This painting depicts a still life with apples. Cézanne loved to paint fruits and simple objects to study shapes and colours. He is considered one of the artists who paved the way for modern art.



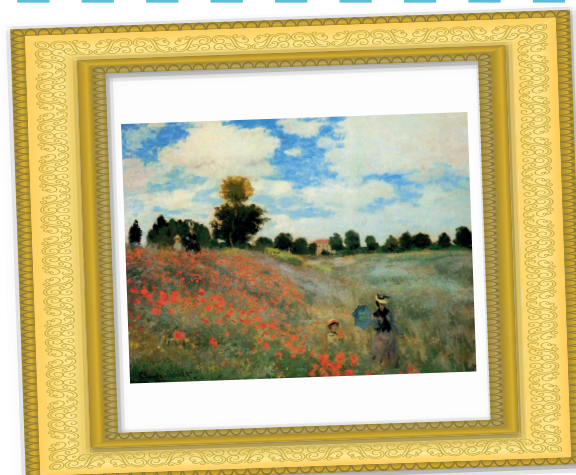
## Vincent van Gogh

Arcimboldo is known for his amazing portraits made from elements of nature. In this painting, the face is entirely made of flowers, symbolizing spring.



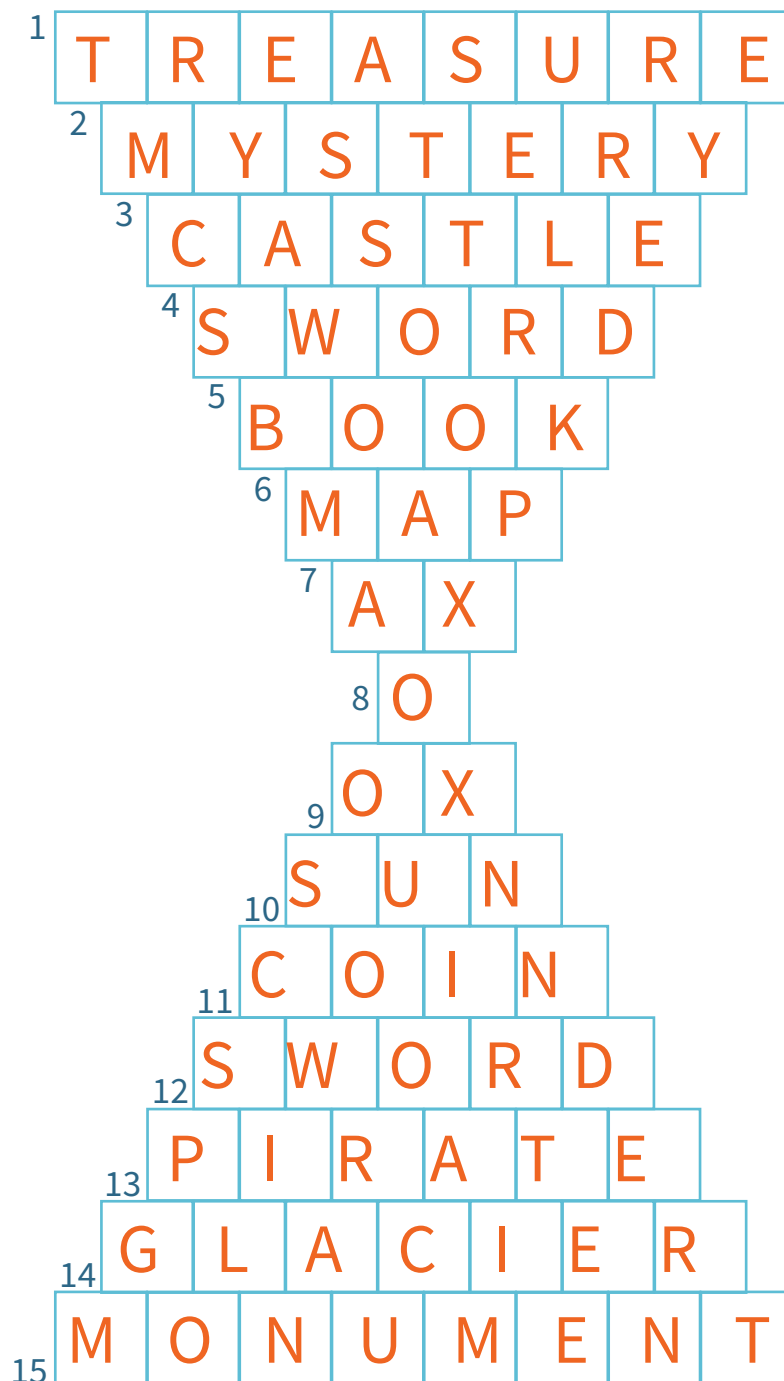
## Claude Monet

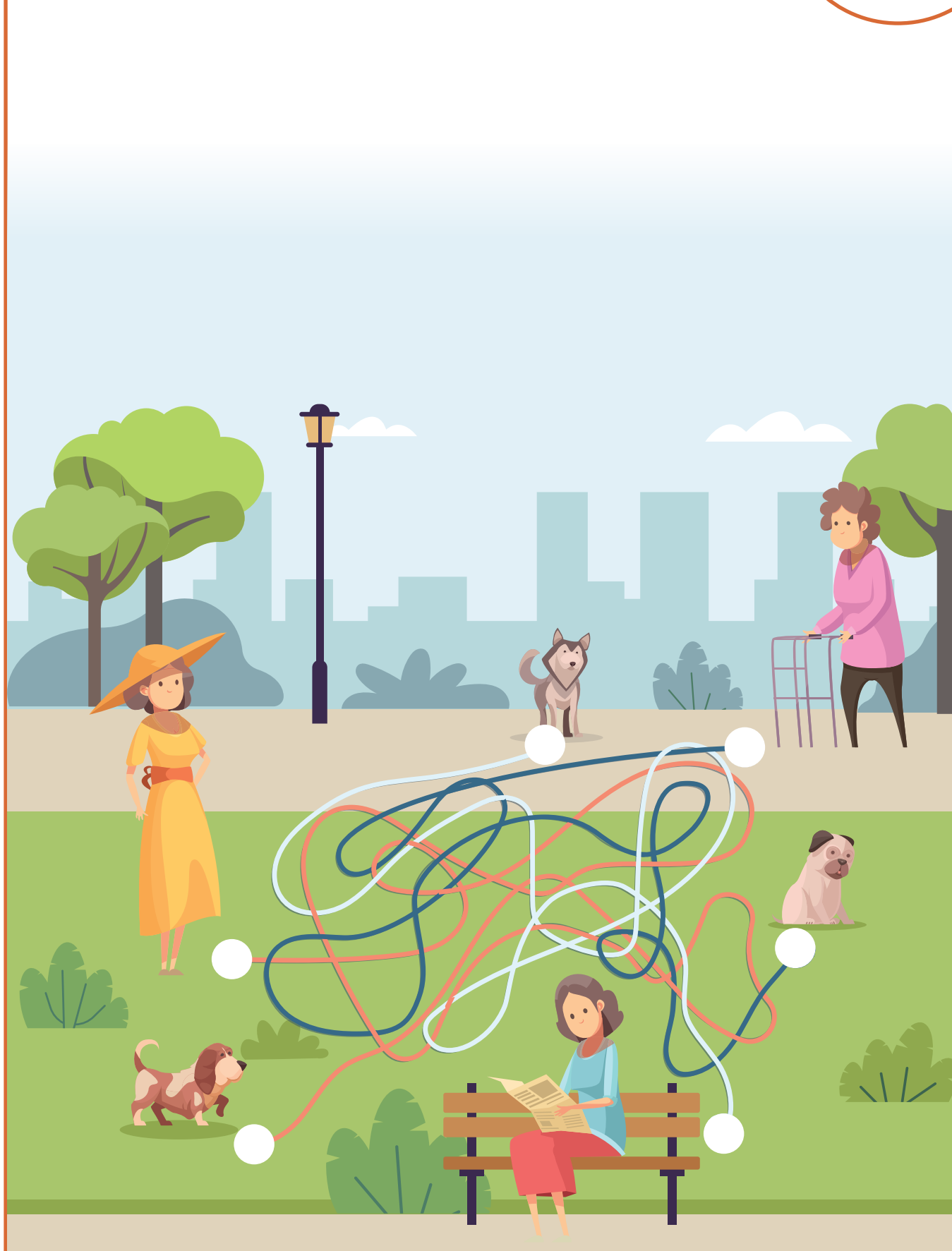
