– Winter Special –

Try to solve the number sequence by working out the value of each snowflake.

$$\text{Snowflake 1} + \text{Snowflake 1} + \text{Snowflake 1} = 6$$

$$\text{Snowflake 2} + \text{Snowflake 1} + \text{Snowflake 1} = 16$$

$$\text{Snowflake 2} + \text{Snowflake 3} + \text{Snowflake 2} = 29$$

$$\text{Snowflake 3} \times \text{Snowflake 2} + \text{Snowflake 1} = \boxed{\text{---}}$$
