Calculate the estimated average temperature for the following years, then plot each value on the temperature scale and join them to show the change over time.



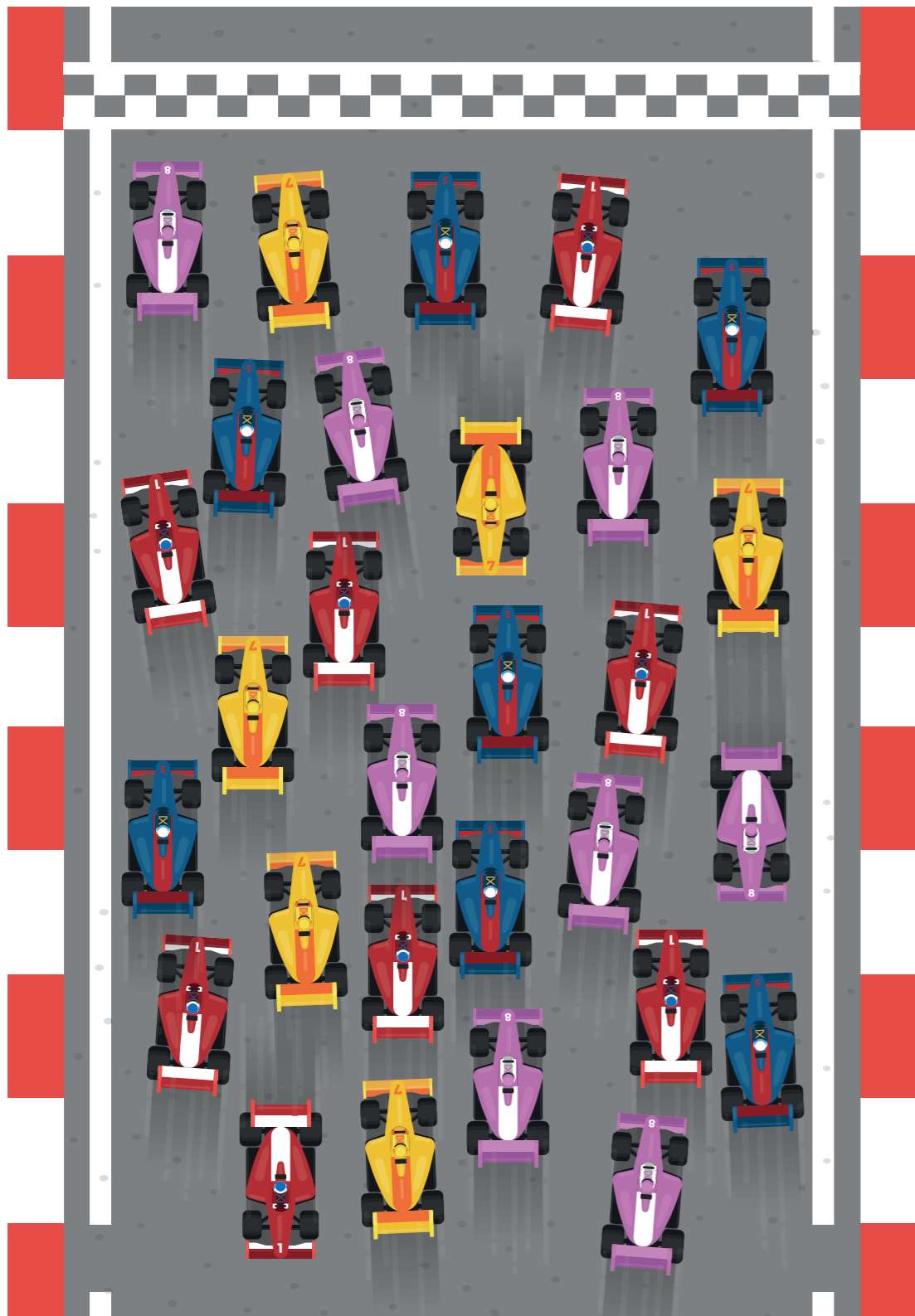
