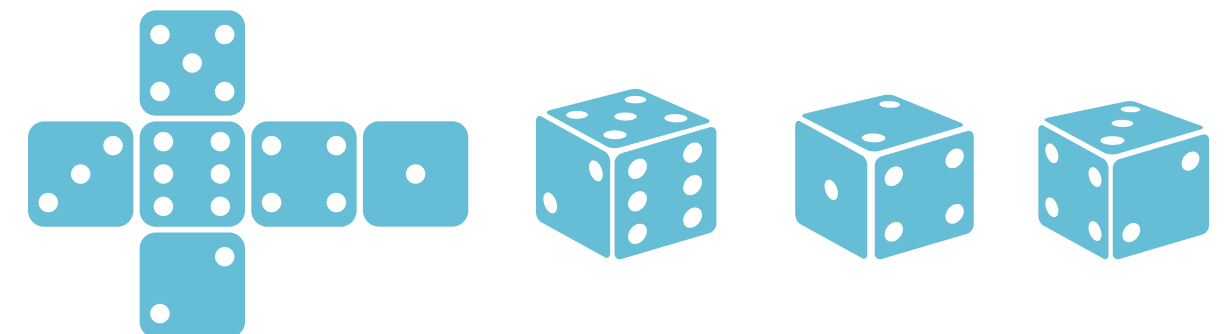

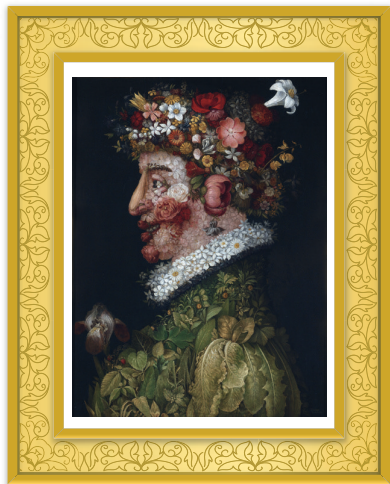

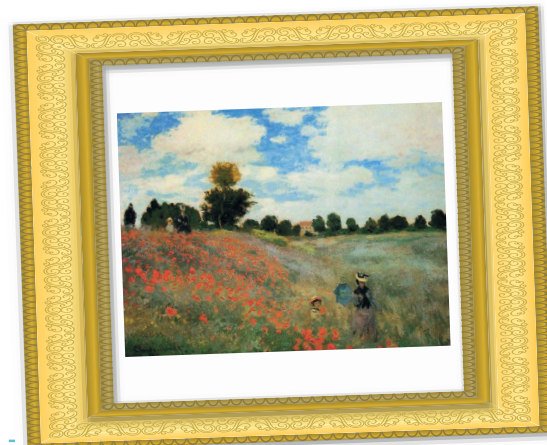

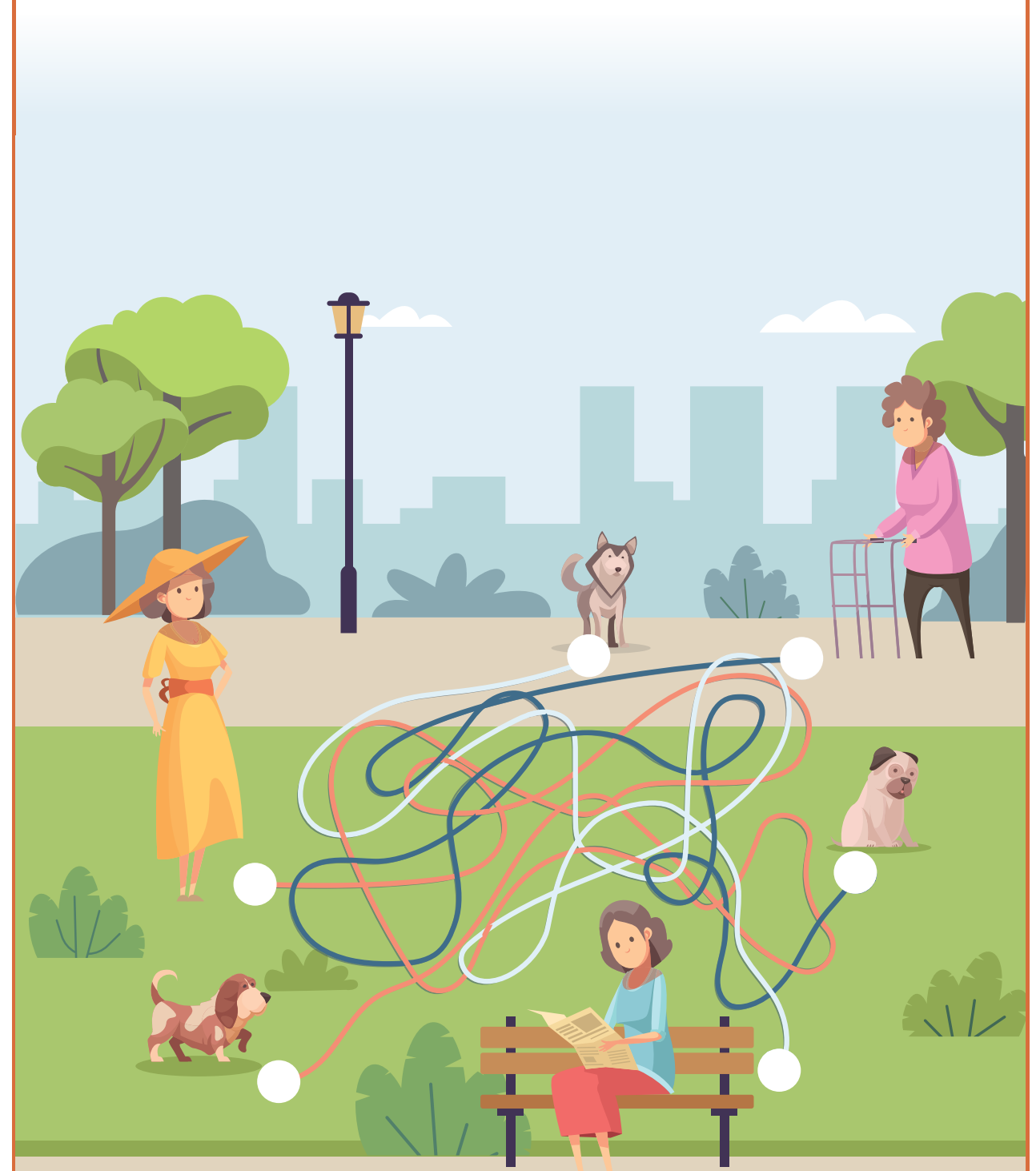

This painting depicts a still life with apples. Cézanne loved to paint fruits and simple objects to study shapes and colors. He is considered one of the artists who paved the way for modern art.



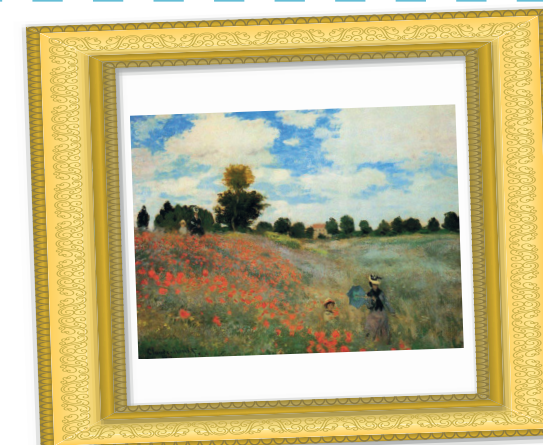
Giuseppe Arcimboldo

The Sunflowers are one of Van Gogh's most famous series of paintings. He used very bright colors and thick brushstrokes to bring a lot of life to his artworks.

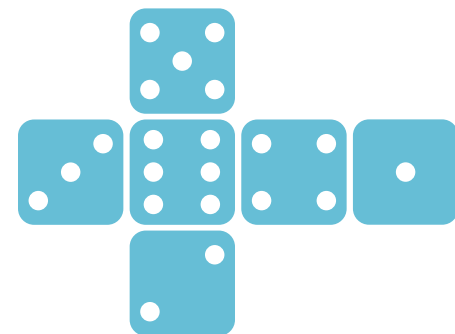
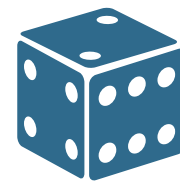
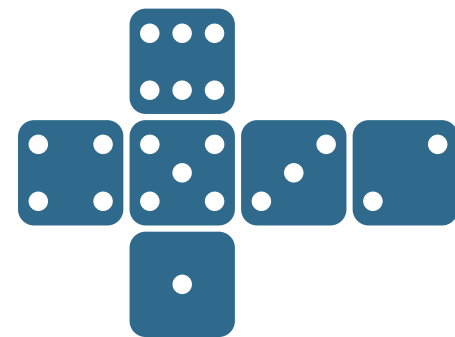


Claude Monet
