- B** On September 16, Mexico celebrates its independence. This day commemorates the "Grito de Dolores" of 1810, when Miguel Hidalgo called on the people to rise up against Spanish rule. It is a symbolic date marked by parades and celebrations throughout the country.

2. Who was elected the first president of the United States in 1789, following the adoption of the Constitution in September 1787?

- B** George Washington became the first president of the United States in 1789, two years after the U.S. Constitution was signed in 1787.

3. On September 15, 1830, in England, what was inaugurated?

- C** The first railway line, opened in 1830, connected Liverpool and Manchester. It was the first in the world designed to transport passengers on a regular route with the help of a steam locomotive.

4. Which Soviet probe landed on the Moon on September 13, 1959?

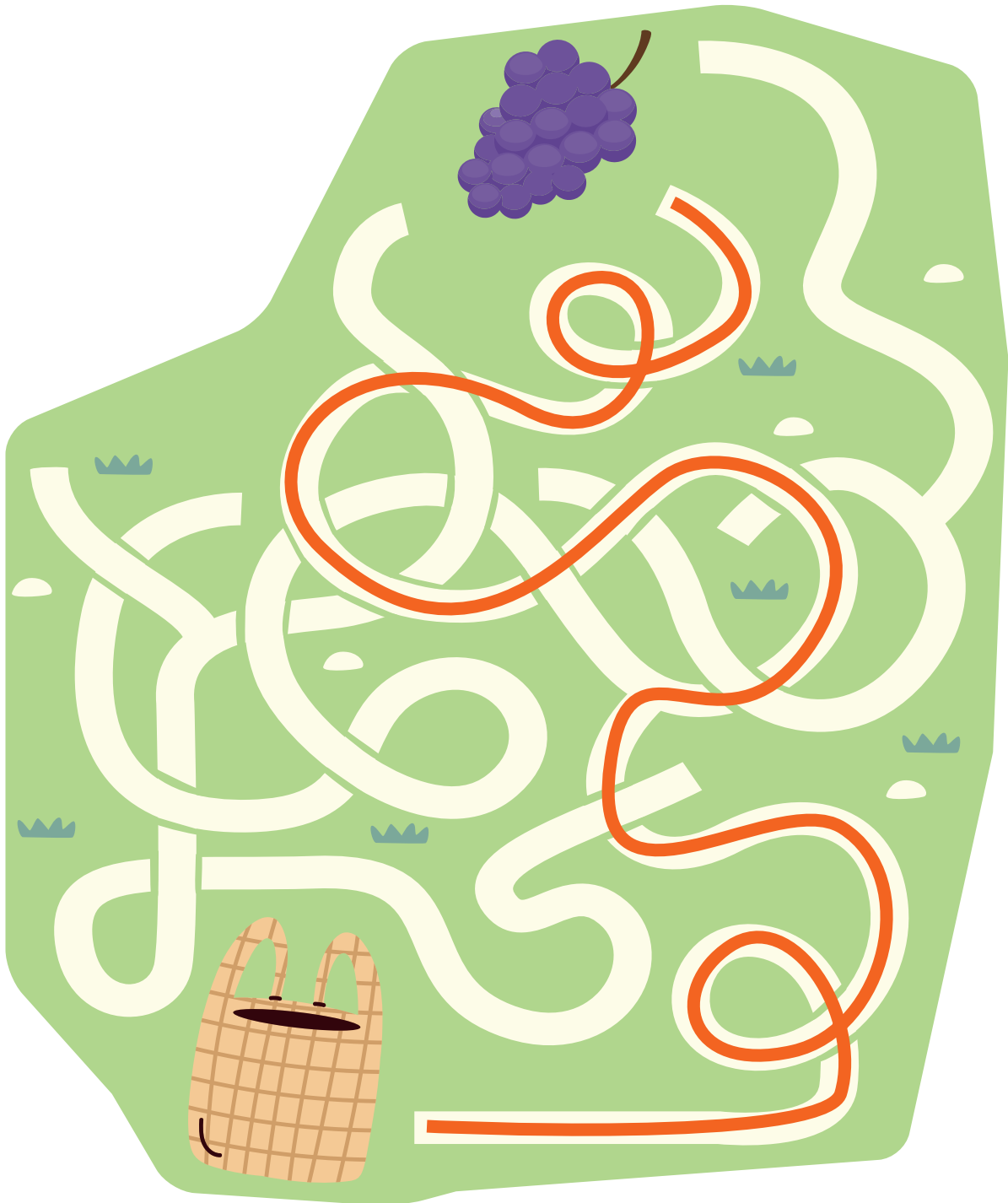
- C** On September 13, 1959, the Soviet probe Luna 2 became the first human-made object to land on the Moon. It crashed near the Sea of Serenity, marking a historic milestone in space exploration.

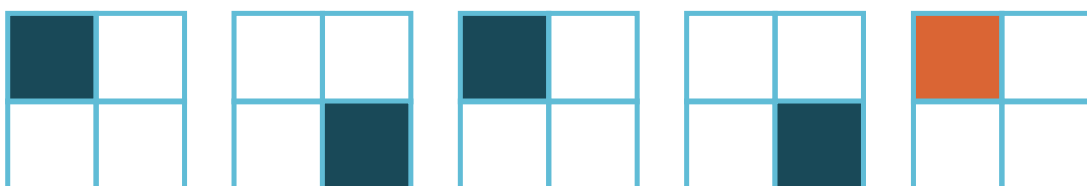
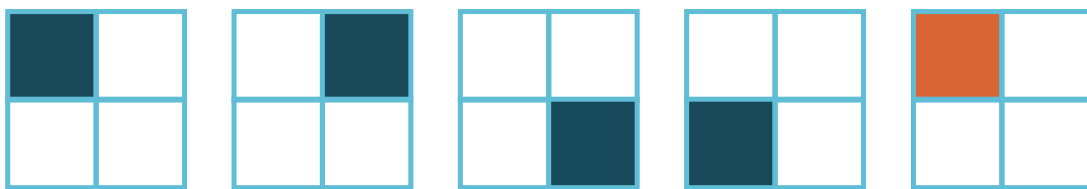
